The EarthView team is glad you are considering an EarthView visit to your school. We have found this to be a truly remarkable way to generate enthusiasm for geography education among people of all ages!

1. For the EarthView Globe program, the gymnasium must have a height with no obstructions of at least 20 feet for EarthView 1 (hand-painted) and 22 feet for EarthView 2 (satellite image). It is

- 9. Please be sure that the gym floor has been swept clean prior to the event.
- 10. The EarthView team will arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the first class scheduled. Please ensure that office and/or school security staff is ready for the team's arrival, and that any special parking or entrance requirements are communicated to the team prior to the program.
- 11. Students should be in the gymnasium only immediately prior to the program. It would be best to have a class waiting outside the door to enter as a class leaves so transition between classes runs smoothly through the program. There should be no talking outside EarthView as sound carries and interferes with the lessons taking place inside.
- 12. The students in each group should all be at the same grade level, so that an appropriate program can be presented to them, though groups from any range of grade levels can be included over the course of the day.

A teacher or aide accompany each group of students to the EarthView presentation and assist with classroom management.
